MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR BUILDING A DECK PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION

- Correct Civic Address
- □ Legal Description
- □ Application fee see Fees and Charges Bylaw
- All drawings to scale
- □ Within 50 m of a watercourse (if applicable) Yes No
- Within a Development Permit Area Yes No

(See Official Community Plan)

DOCUMENTS

Building Permit Application Form

- □ Application (With signed owners acknowledgment if submitted by contractor)
- Designer or (Architect for buildings greater than 3 storeys in building height or over 600 m2 in 1 level area.)
 - Structural signed & sealed by a Registered Professional (Not required if deck is for a house)
 - o Letters of Assurance sealed by a Registered Professional (Not required if deck is for a house)
- □ Schedules B for each registered professional (Not required if deck is for a house)
- **D** Registered Professional's Proof of Insurance (Not required if deck is for a house)
- □ Schedule A (BC Building Code) –applicable if more than one registered professional has been retained.

PLANS (2 complete sets)

- Site Plan
- □ Foundation/Framing Plans
- Elevations
- □ Construction Details/Cross Section

NOTE: All <u>plans</u> submitted with permit applications shall include the name and address of the designer.
