

AND WHEREAS at the October 21, 2024 Committee of the Whole Meeting, in consideration of Strategic Planning Initiative 25-PI-02: Paid Permitted Parking Plan for Uptown Businesses, Committee of the Whole recommended to Council THAT a \$10,000 budget provision for the Initiative titled Paid Permitted Parking Plan for Uptown Businesses be included in fiscal 2026 of the 2025 - 2029 Financial Plan; AND FURTHER THAT the Initiative titled Paid Permitted Parking Plan for Uptown Businesses becomes part of the scope of work of the Initiative titled Parking Management Strategy with a total combined project budget of \$30,000 in fiscal 2026 of the 2025-2029 Financial Plan.

AND WHEREAS at the November 1, 2024 Committee of the Whole meeting, Committee of the Whole discussed the need for more information on “parking-in-lieu” provisions before discussing Capital Strategic Planning Initiative 25-CAP-PI-02: Miscellaneous Parking Improvements further with the recommendation on the floor being subsequently withdrawn.

AND WHEREAS at the November 13, 2024 Committee of the Whole Meeting, in consideration of Strategic Planning Initiative 25-CAP-PI-02: Miscellaneous Parking Improvements, Committee of the Whole recommended to Council:

THAT consideration of parking on Primrose Street be included in the Parking Strategy Review planned for fiscal 2026; AND FURTHER THAT consideration of expansion of the Civic Centre parking be included in the Parking Strategy Review planned for fiscal 2026; AND FURTHER THAT the exploration of parking opportunities on Fern Road West be referred to the Parking Strategy Review planned for 2026.

THAT the Committee of the Whole recommends to Council THAT review of the “Town of Qualicum Beach Off-Street Parking and Reserve Fund Bylaw No. 500.02, 2005” scheduled for 2028 be advanced to fiscal 2026 and combined with the Parking Strategy Review; AND FURTHER THAT the budget for review of the “Town of Qualicum Beach Off-Street Parking and Reserve Fund Bylaw No. 500.02, 2005” with a budget provision of \$12k and the Parking Strategy Review with a budget provision of \$20k be combined for a budget provision of \$32k in fiscal 2026.

Councillor Young MOVED and Councillor Skipsey SECONDED, THAT Committee of the Whole wishes to rescind and consolidate the recommendations and recommends to Council:

THAT Strategic Initiative Scoping Sheets 25-PI-02: Paid Permitted Parking Plan for Uptown Businesses and 24-GG-13: Develop a “Cash-in-lieu of Parking” Bylaw be closed by Council resolution.

THAT Scoping Sheet 24-PI-02 be renamed "Parking Management Strategy Including Review of Off-Street Parking and Reserve Fund Bylaw No. 500.02 & Paid Permitted Parking Plan for Uptown Businesses."

THAT a total budget provision of \$42,000 be included in fiscal 2026 of the 2025-2029 Financial Plan for the Initiative titled Parking Management Strategy Including Review of Off-Street Parking and Reserve Fund Bylaw No. 500.02 & Paid Permitted Parking Plan for Uptown Businesses.

THAT \$12,000 be funded from Capacity Funding and \$30,000 be funded from the Strategic Initiatives Reserve for the Strategic Initiative titled Parking Management Strategy Including Review of Off-Street Parking and Reserve Fund Bylaw No. 500.02 & Paid Permitted Parking Plan for Uptown Businesses.
