# **Introductory Open House**

March 31, 2025 – 2:00pm-7:00pm @ East & West Hall (Pioneer Hall), Civic Centre

### **Description:**

This event will introduce the 2025 OCP Review to the community, and includes an overview of how community members can participate in the process. Presentations will be made at 2:00pm, 4:00pm, and 6:00pm explaining the purpose of the OCP, what the OCP Review will look like and how people can get involved, and give a brief explanation of the topics set for discussion.

Following the presentation, there will be four separate participation stations/tables, each dedicated to one of the four housing topics of the OCP:

- 1. WHO should new housing support the most?
- 2. WHERE should new housing and density be located in the community?
- 3. WHAT should new housing look like?
- 4. HOW should the Town be involved in housing?

At each table, a facilitator will guide a discussion on the topic. There will be additional topic experts floating between tables and providing context and information as needed. These are not formal sign-up sessions, and the conversation will vary depending on the participants, though discussions will be limited to the topic at hand. Ideas and conversations that come up but are not within the scope of the topic may be recorded in an "ideas parking lot" for discussion at another time or during another project, if relevant.
