Select Committee on Beach Day Celebration Terms of Reference Meeting Date Amendment

Council authorized staff to amend the Terms of Reference for the Select Committee on Beach Day Celebration to change regular meeting dates to the last Monday of each month.

<u>Select Committee on Environment & Sustainability Terms</u> of Reference Definition of Youth Member

Council authorized the amendment of the Terms of Reference for the Select Committee on Environment & Sustainability to clarify the definition of a Youth Member.

2025 OCP Review Annual Plan

Council approved, in principle, the 2025 OCP Review Annual Plan including a process for reviewing the Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 800, 2018 by the December 31, 2025 deadline.

Community Emergency Preparedness Fund Grant Application

Council authorized the submission of a grant application in the amount of \$80,000 to the 2025 Community Emergency Preparedness Fund (CEPF) for the "Emergency Operations Centres Equipment and Training" project. Council further authorized The Town of Qualicum Beach apply for, receive, and manage the grant funding on behalf of Emergency Management Oceanside.

Development Variance Permit | 2955 Island Highway West

Council refused the Development Variance Permit application for 2955 Island Highway West.

<u>Development Permit | 389 Burnham Road and 391</u> Burnham Road

Council authorized the issuance of a Development Permit for 389 Burham Road and 391 Burham Road to permit retopping of four Western Red Cedar trees, with limb removal, to re-open a view corridor.

Development Permit | 1000 Ravensbourne Lane

Council authorized the issuance of a Form and Character Development Permit for 1000 Ravensbourne Lane subject to Council consideration and authorization of a lease agreement with the applicant. The specific lease location is to be determined by Council and in accordance with the Qualicum Beach Airport Water Supply and Sewer Service policy.

<u>Village Way Improvements at Kwalikum Secondary School</u> <u>Grant Application</u>

Council authorized the submission of a grant application in the amount of \$197,000 to the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure's *Active Transportation Fund* for the purpose of implementing road safety improvements along Village Way fronting Kwalikum Secondary School.
